

First conditional (1)

Future real /possible situations

If I **become** President I **will invest** in an infrastructure for civic renewal - not just roads, but schools, playgrounds, parks, health clinics, libraries.



A candidate in an election

Second conditional (2)

Present/Future imaginary situations

If I **became** President, I **would reduce** working week to 20 hours.



A lazy man

Third conditional (3)

Unreal past situations

If I **had become** president, I **would have lowered** taxes.



A man who almost became president

CONDITIONALS

First conditional (1)

Future real /possible situations

If + present , will + infinitive

*If we **play** chess, I'll win.*

Second conditional (2)

Present/Future imaginary situations

If + past , would + infinitive

*If we **played** chess, I would win.*

Third conditional (3)

Unreal past situations

If + past perfect, would have + past participle

*If we **had played** chess, I would have won.*

Present Simple

+

I, you, we, they **make**
He, she, it **makes**

-

I, you, we, they **don't make**
He, she, it **doesn't make**

?

Do I, you, we, they **make**?
Does he, she, it **make**?

Past Perfect

+

I, we, you, they **had made**
He, she, it

-

I, we, you, they **hadn't made**
He, she, it

?

Had I, we, you, they **made**?
He, she, it

Past Simple

+

Regular verbs (cook, want, walk..)

I, you, we, they
He, she, it

cooked
wanted
walked

Irregular verbs (make, do, go...)

I, you, we, they
He, she, it

made
did
went

-

I, we, you, they
He, she, it

didn't cook
didn't want
didn't walk
didn't make
didn't do
didn't go

?

Did

I, you, we, they
He, she, it

cook, want, walk, make, do, go ?
